Closing Date For Volunteer Applications for the World Meeting of Families 2018! We are only three months away from one of the biggest events of the Catholic Church and the single largest occasion in Ireland this year – the World Meeting of Families 2018. Pope Francis has confirmed that he will be here with us and hundreds of thousands of pilgrims will attend the events from 21st – 26th August 2018. We need the help of several thousand volunteers for the event and the cut-off deadline to apply is the 31st May 2018! This deadline will allow us to complete Garda vetting, reference checking, and training for all our volunteers in time for our event in August. The Deacon: Called To Serve: On Sunday 17 June at 3pm in St Michael's Church, Enniskillen, Martin Donnelly of Enniskillen will be ordained as the first permanent deacon in our diocese since the diaconate was re-introduced by Vatican II as a 'distinct ministry of service'. All are welcome to witness Martin's ordination. What Does A Deacon Do? A deacon is ordained, so therefore the ministry of deacon is one of service – at the altar, of the Word of God and in promoting charity in the community. Deacons serve at the altar during Mass, bring the Eucharist to the sick at home and in hospital, preside at the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction, celebrate Baptism and Marriages and preside at Funeral Rites such as reception and burial. A deacon also leads the celebration of the Liturgy of the Hours (Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer) and the Liturgy of the Word (outside of Mass). A deacon may proclaim the Gospel and preach the homily at any liturgy and can lead sacramental preparation and renewal programmes for other ministries in the parish. The work of the deacon in the community is very important. This may include the visitation of the sick, the bereaved and those in prison. A deacon has a very important role in the promotion of justice and human rights.
