Recent Plenary Meeting of Church-State Dialogue: Chai Brady in the current edition of *The Irish Catholic* reporting on the 3.5hr meeting that took place between the Government of The Republic of Ireland and 28 representatives of Churches, Faith Communities and Non-Confessional Organisations said the meeting was structured under three headings: effective dialogue, inclusive and diverse communities, and education. Dublin's Archbishop Diarmuid Martin raised the difficult process of moving towards a greater pluralism in school patronage and in the challenges faced by parents of children with autism.

Confirmation before First Communion? Bishop James S. Wall of New Mexico recently stated the practice of postponing the reception of Confirmation until the teenage years has not always been beneficial. An alarming percentage of Catholic children in his diocese do not continue their formation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, and in too many cases, never receive the sacrament. Bishop Wall proposes celebrating Confirmation before First Communion. His diocese is the 13th American diocese to do so (taken from the July/August 2019 Intercom, p37).
