Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls
Indulgences are acts by which one expresses hope that a loved one who has died is with God. The living can support the deceased with their prayers to accept God's welcome. The tradition is that between 12 noon on November 1st until midnight on November 2nd, Catholics confess sins, received Holy Communion and pray for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) or visit a church and there recite one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed or attend the Sacrament of Penance in the week following November 1st or receive Holy Communion on any day from Nov 1st to Nov 8th or visit a cemetery and pray for the deceased once per day from November 1st to November 8th.

Confessions: St. Tierney's – Friday, 1st November after 9.30am Mass and 7.30pm Mass and Saturday 2nd after 9.30am Mass. St. Mary's – Friday, 1st November after 10.30am Mass and Saturday 2nd after 10.30am Mass.
