World Day Of The Poor is marked throughout the Church on this Sunday, in response to the request of Pope Francis who will himself celebrate Mass in St Peter's Square and afterwards eat lunch with over 1,000 poor people. The theme this year is "The hope of the poor shall not perish for ever" (Ps. 9:19). Pope Francis points out that today people are trapped in new forms of slavery and it is the duty of Catholics not only to provide the poor with relief services, but with spiritual hope.
