To enlarge the screen image, click on the icon on the bottom right corner of the screen. The screen shows the sanctuary only from the baptism font to the statue of Our Lady by the candelabra. In relation to funerals and weddings a family will be requested prior to the event if they wish the event to be streamed and recorded. Where they wish to have it recorded and view it later privately they will be given a different password to 'Pottiagh'. They are also free to refuse. This is comply with GDPR.

THE GOSPEL John 14:15-21

Jesus said to his disciples:

If you love me you will keep my commandments.

I shall ask the Father,

and he will give you another Advocate

to be with you for ever,

that Spirit of truth

whom the world can never receive

since it neither sees nor knows him;

but you know him,

because he is with you, he is in you.

I will not leave you orphans;

I will come back to you.

In a short time the world will no longer see me;

Anybody who receives my commandments

and keeps them will be one who loves me;

and anybody who loves me

will be loved by my Father,

and I shall love him and show myself to him.'

Cardinal Tomás Ó Fiaich: May 8th past was the 30th anniversary of the death of Cardinal Tomás in Toulouse. Some will recall he was on a pilgrimage to Lourdes when suddenly he took unwell and died in a hospital in Toulouse, he was 66. If he were alive today he would be 97 years.

Saint Pope John Paul II: Monday 18th May would have been the 100th birthday of Saint Pop John Paul II. He said:

'We shall not be saved by a formula but by a Person, and the assurance which he gives us: I am with you! It is not therefore a matter of inventing a "new programme". The programme already exists: it is the plan found in the Gospel and in the living Tradition it is the same as ever. Ultimately, it has its centre in Christ himself, who is to be known, loved and imitated, so that in him we may live the life of the Trinity, and with him transform history until its fulfilment in the heavenly Jerusalem. This is a programme which does not change with shifts of times and cultures, even though it takes account of time and culture for the sake of true dialogue and effective communication. This programme for all times is our programme for the Third Millennium.'
