Townlands and Masses: The allocation of townlands to the return to Masses in the parish is simply to give to people the opportunity to attend. No one is obliged as the Sunday obligation is currently dispensed.

St. Tierney's Church: Under revised Dept. Health NI gatherings for funerals inside the church are determined by the size of the church and the application of the 2 metre rule. Therefore seating downstairs is restricted to 16 benches or 16 households, its members seated together as per normal. NI Dept. Health guidelines permit no more than 30 at the graveside.

St. Mary's Church: Church gatherings must be no more than 40 people excluding church/parish personnel. Under Dept. Health guidelines no more than 50 are permitted inside the a building. The restriction also applies to baptisms, weddings and funerals.

Hand-sanitisers and Masks: Those attending Mass and other liturgies in the parish's two churches may wear a mask (their own) and bring their own hand-sanitiser.

Be early to the church: Those attending Mass are recommended to be present 15 minutes before the time of Mass. Ushers will record for the purpose of contact-tracing the names of those attending.

Ministers of the Word: For the short time there will be no Ministers of the Word and no collectors. There will be a rota to facilitate 1 Minister of the Eucharist each Sunday in St. Tierney's and the minister will wear a visor.

There will not be a Eucharistic Minister for the moment in St. Mary's Church.

Thanks to all the Volunteers helping with the return to Mass. Such good will and generosity of spirit. There are two groups, St. Tierney's and St. Mary's. The ushers at each liturgy also undertake the cleaning of surfaces directly after Mass. St. Mary's volunteers will meet at 7pm in St. Mary's on Monday 13th July to review how the return is going and St. Tierney's volunteers have arranged to meet for the same in St. Tierney's at 7pm on Tuesday 14th July. More volunteers are needed to share out the load as restrictions may continue for longer than thought. Please feel free to come along to the next meeting.

Blessing of the Graves: Fr. Chester conducted a private blessing of the graves, St. Mary's on 26th June and St. Tierney's on 27th June. Recordings were by Tony Hughes.
