Feast of Christ the King:

The Feast of Christ the King falls on the last Sunday of the liturgical year. The Preface of the Mass states Christ is the eternal Priest and King of all Creation who brings about by his sacrifice on the altar of the Cross, a kingdom of truth and life, holiness and grace, justice, love and peace.

'Living our Faith through Prayer and Action.'

The above title is the title of a pastoral letter which Bishop Larry has asked priests to read at Masses for the weekend of Feast of Christ the King. Advent Service of Hope led by Bishop Duffy: This online service will be broadcast at 5pm on Saturday 28th Nov, the Vigil of the First Sunday of Advent via www.clogherdiocese.ie and the Diocese of Clogher Facebook page as well as local parish Facebook pages. This is a chance for us all as the Church here in Clogher to be united spiritually. Let us join together in prayer as we turn to God and place before Him, in hope and expectation, the cares and worries of this time.

Advent begins next Sunday 29th November.

New Northern Ireland Corona Virus Restrictions: New restrictions take effect this Thursday mid-night to Friday 11th December. Churches in Northern Ireland, including St. Tierney's Church, will be closed and Masses offered on-line only. Funerals continue to be restricted to 25 mourners. Baptisms will not be celebrated during this period. Hopefully the restrictions will reduce substantially the R number.

Weddings: All weddings scheduled for 2020 in the Parish of Roslea were postponed to 2021 and beyond. 17 weddings are booked for next year. Let's hope these will go ahead as planned.

Corona Virus Restrictions in the Republic of Ireland: Current Level 5 restrictions that have closed churches to public Masses continue to December 2nd. We wait to see if restrictions affecting places of worship are lifted by then.
