This Week's Feasts:

Wednesday: St. Macartan, bishop & patron of Clogher Diocese, 5th Century.

Thursday: The Annunciation of the Lord.

NI Executive restrictions: The Bishops of Northern Ireland announced on St. Patrick's Day that Masses before a congregation will commence on Friday 26th March.

- The obligation on Sundays and Holy Days continues to be dispensed.
- Funerals limited to 25 people present, including the priest, sacristan and singers. No pre or post-funeral gatherings, not even wakes.
- Baptisms limited to 15 in attendance.
- It is hoped that the First Communion and Confirmation will go ahead on the dates scheduled.
- Organist and no more than 2 singers permitted may provide music at Mass.

Republic of Ireland:

- No announcement on the recommencement of Masses with a congregation.
- **There will be a review on April 1st.**
- St. Mary's Church is open for private worship. Attendance at funerals is limited to 10.
- **The Bishops have recommended the postponement of First Communion and Confirmation for the time being. It is hoped the sacraments will go ahead in Roslea Parish as previously scheduled.**
- The Bishops continue to keep in prayer all who are suffering in this time of Covid, and all who contribute so much to their care.
