This Week's Feasts:

- Monday: St. Irenaeus, bishop & martyr. He lived shortly after the Apostles and was Bishop of Lyons. He sought to win people to the faith by love than by fear.
- Tuesday: Ss. Peter and Paul, Apostles. They are celebrated on the day of the foundation of the city of Rome by Romulus. Peter died by crucifixion and Paul was beheaded between 64 – 67CE.
- Wednesday: The First Martyrs of the Holy Roman Church who persecuted in 64CE during the reign of Nero.
- Thursday: St. Oliver Plunkett, bishop & martyr. Consecrated Archbishop of Armagh in 1669 and put to death at Tyburn in 1681, hanged, drawn, and quartered.
- Saturday: St. Thomas, Apostle. Martyred in India.

NI Executive Restrictions: Congregations are welcome at public worship. Social distancing, sanitising and other mitigations will be in place. Ushers will see you to a seat.

- Funerals & Weddings: Attendance is determined by the 2m rule of social distancing and the size of the building. St. Tierney's Church holds about 100 people, i.e. quarter capacity.
