Feast Days This Week.

Sunday: The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The doctrine teaches that her death, Mary was assumed into Heaven both body and soul. Where she has gone we hope to follow.

Tuesday: Our Lady of Knock. A miraculous apparition was witnessed by 15 people on 21st August 1879 of Our Lady, St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist.

Friday: St. Bernard, abbot and doctor of the Church, 1090 – 1153, a Cistercian monk at Cîteaux in France, abbot at Clairvaux, patron of beekeepers.

Saturday: St. Pius X, pope, 1835 – 1914, pope from 1903.
