Feast Days This Week.

Monday: St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein), Virgin & Martyr, Patron of Europe (1891 – 1942). A Jewish convert to Catholicism, she became a Carmelite nun. She was murdered at Auschwitz.

Tuesday: St. Lawrence, deacon & martyr, 3rd century.

Wednesday: St. Clare of Assisi, Virgin, (1193 – 1253) companion of St. Francis and ruler of the Poor Clare Sisters.

Friday: St. Fachtna, bishop, 7th Century. Abbot of the principal monastery in West Cork.
