World Mission Sunday

World Mission Sunday is the Holy Father's annual appeal for spiritual and financial support so that the life-giving work of overseas mission and missionaries can continue. The theme this year is *'We Cannot Remain Silent – We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard (Acts 4:20)'*. It is a message of hope – Jesus Christ is risen; we cannot keep his love, compassion, and mercy to ourselves. It also challenges us to stand up and speak out on behalf of those who are weaker. World Mission Sunday is the one Sunday of the year when the entire global Church comes together in support of mission. Through the generosity of parishioners and donors, we can reach out to offer aid to struggling communities. All donations from this world papal collection support churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the churches are too new, young or poor to sustain themselves fully. Proceeds from this week's Blue envelope will go towards World Mission Sunday.
