Wednesday: St. Malachy, bishop. (1094 – 1190), abbot of the abbey at Bangor, founder of the abbey at Melifont, Bishop of Connor (1124), Archbishop of Armagh in 1132, Died in the abbey of Clairvaux in France enroute to Rome.

Thursday: St. Charles Borromeo, bishop, 1538 – 84, Italian, Cardinal Archbishop of Milan, worked for the reform of the Church at the Council of Trent.

Friday: St. Martin de Porres (1579 – 1639). Peruvian, an ex-slave, became a Dominican lay brother, a pharmacist and a nurse, spent his life serving the sick and the poor.
