Thursday: Our Lady of the Rosary.

Saturday: St. John Henry Newman, priest. Canonised 13th October 2019. On this day 1845 he was received into the Catholic Church. He assisted in the setting up of a Catholic

university, UCD and wrote on his understanding of Christian education.
