Feast Days this Week:

Monday: St. John Bosco, priest, 1815 – 1888. Born in Piedmont in Northern Italy. He founded the Salesian Order after the name of St. Francis de Sales. The order specialised in the education of young boys during the Italian Industrial Revolution.

Tuesday: St. Brigid, Abbess & Secondary Patron of Ireland, born in the mid 5th century at Faughert, near Dundalk. She founded a monastery at Kildare.

Wednesday: The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (the 4th Joyful Mystery of the Most Holy Rosary), also known as Candlemas Day when candles are blessed. Mary and Joseph brought the infant Jesus to the Temple to be circumcised, and there they met Simeon and Anna who greeted Jesus as Son of God.

Thursday: St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, born in Armenia and martyred in Turkey in the 4th century. He is reputed to have rescued a boy choking on a fish bone.

Saturday: St. Agatha, virgin & martyr. Born in Sicily in the 3rd century. She is named in the First Eucharistic Prayer.
