**Blessing of the Graves:** It is fantastic that people are free to gather this year in the church graveyards of the Parish of Roslea for the annual Blessing of the Graves. The annual blessing brings families together to remember their deceased family members and friends, and it also serves in a midyear sprucing up of the family plot. I wish to pay tribute to all for maintaining their family plot throughout the year and therefore keeping up the appearance of the church grounds to such a high standard. I am grateful to Brendan McDermott who mows the grass fortnightly in St. Tierney's Church Graveyard and Eugene Byrne of the Community Employment Scheme for attending to the grass in St. Mary's Church with assistance from Sacristan, Hugh McGuirk. The ceremony of 'Blessing the Graves' is chiefly a celebration of Baptism in which people are invited to participate at the graveside in the renewal of Baptismal Promises, making the Sign of the Cross, and reciting, *'By this blessed water we call to mind our baptism into Christ who by his death and resurrection has redeemed the world.'* Next a family member sprinkles the plot with the blessed water. **Trócaire - one person to die from hunger every 48 seconds in the Horn of Africa:** The Horn of Africa facing its fourth consecutive year of drought and in Somalia, Kenya and Ethiopia one person is likely to die from hunger every 48 seconds, while approximately 5.7 million children are acutely malnourished. The United Nations warns that 350,000 children could die by the autumn unless action is taken. The Bishops of Ireland call on Government, and the international community, to act immediately to end this hunger crisis, which may be achievable if a concerted effort is made now.
