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Sunday 5th June 2022 – The Solemnity of Pentecost

Bishop Larry Duffy wishes the priests on Pentecost Sunday to draw attention to the forthcoming Synod and give thanks for the diocesan phase of the Synod. The word 'synod' means 'syn = together', 'odo = on the way' and involves the laity and the whole church on a listening process for the road ahead. The Diocesan Synodal Steering Group will meet in the coming months to discuss how best to prepare for the Irish Synod. The report will be fed to Rome in preparation for the Synod of Bishops in Rome in October 2023.

THE SYNOD PRAYER ADSUMUS SANCTE SPIRITUS, (the first words of the Latin original meaning, "We stand before you, Holy Spirit,") *We stand before you, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions. Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right. All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever.*
