Bishop Duffy's Pastoral Letter entitled "Our Baptism Calls us to Serve in New Ways" will be read at all Masses this Sunday throughout the Diocese of Clogher. Copies of the letter are available in the churches of the parish.

For Saints' Feasts of the coming week go to the bottom righthand corner of the rear page of the Mass missalette.

St. Tierney's Church was erected by Parish Priest Fr. Thomas Bogue (1789 – 1841) and was consecrated in 1837. The belltower was erected in 1834 and the bell, cast by Sheridan's of Dublin, was presented by Fr. Bogue to the Church. McKenna's History of the Diocese states, '*It was only in 1829 that it became legal to erect or use a bell in connection with a Catholic Church in Ireland.*' Another

source states, it was *'the first regularly built belfry and bell erected in the North of Ireland within a period of 300 years.'*

St. Mary's Church in the townland of Templetate was also erected by Fr. Bogue, see above, in the 1830's when the Ulster Canal was under construction. It was built with a porous stone and it required major renovation in 1859. The date stone at the front gable of the church reads, "*Deo Uni et Trino, Sub Patricinio B. M. Virginis, A.D.1859*", "*One and Triune God, Under the Patronage of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Year of our Lord, 1859.*" Fr. Bogue was appointed Parish Priest of Clones in 1839 and died in 1841. He is buried in the graveyard of St. Tierney's Church.
