Referendums in the Republic of Ireland on Friday 8th March: Three changes are proposed in the 1937 Constitution: **1. Article 41.1.1:** *"The State recognises the Family, whether founded on marriage or other durable relationships, as the natural primary and fundamental unit group of society."* **2. Article 41.2 will be deleted which states,** *"1. In particular, the State recognises that by her life within the home, woman gives to the State a support without which the common good cannot be achieved."* **2.** *"The State shall, therefore, endeavour to ensure that mothers shall not be obliged by economic necessity to engage in labour to the neglect of their duties in the home."* **This is to be replaced by:** *"The State recognises that the provision of care, by members of a family to another by reason of the bonds that exist among them, gives to Society a support without which the common good cannot be achieved and shall strive to support such provision."* **The Government wishes to delete from the Constitution Article 41.3.1:** *"The State pledges itself to guard with special care the Institution of Marriage, on which the Family is founded, and to protect it against attack."* Be informed!
