Last year's Lenten contribution to Trócaire by the Parish of Roslea amounted to £4,976.11 & €4,488.77 for which Trócaire expresses its appreciation. This year's campaign focuses on the exploitation of the people of Guatemala, challenges injustice and highlights the effects of climate change, both of which push families further into poverty. Leonardo, who is a pastoral worker and spiritual leader to the community of Ilma & Julio and their young family, reports: *Due to deadly storms and droughts entire harvests are lost, livelihoods and education opportunities gone. One in every two children under the age of five malnourished. Right now, in Guatemala hardworking families like Ilma and Julio's are being pushed further into poverty by the relentless effects of climate change. Ilma and Julio must choose between school fees that offer hope for tomorrow, and food for their little ones. There is not enough for both anymore. You can help them train in new, climate-resilient farming techniques using seeds and tools that restore soils and protect harvests. You can assist in financing weather-mapping techniques to their community and building the kind of just, sustainable future that should belong to us all. Please be generous!*
