The Feast of the Body & Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ: A special welcome to the children who made their First Communion in May.

The Seven Sacraments are the outreach of Christ in our world. Take Baptism, when the priest pours the water, it is Christ who baptises. Christ forgives in the Prayer of Absolution recited by the priest, and it is Christ who feeds and nourishes in the celebration of the Eucharist. In the Sacrament of Confirmation, He grants the Holy Spirit and in the Sacrament of Matrimony He unites the couple. He reaches out to the world through the ordained priest and in the Sacrament of the Sick it is He who heals.
