St Macartan's Cathedral Restoration – Summer update

Last Autumn, many of you kindly shared your opinions on the restoration work and needed fundraising for St Macartan's Cathedral. The feedback gathered was extensive – 1,401 parishioners in Monaghan & Rackwallace Parish and its 5 neighbouring ones – Donagh, Tyholland, Clontibret, Kilmore & Drumsnatt and Roslea were asked for their thoughts. Given the positive response, the fundraising for this extensive project is underway.

The clergy have received a warm and generous response, and we are deeply grateful to all those across the Diocese who have given their support. In time, we look forward to sharing additional information with all of you. If appropriate for you then, we would appreciate your involvement.

The restoration and preservation are progressing well too. We are at the mid-point of Phase 4 which will be finished by Autumn 2026. Several of the beautiful windows have now been carefully restored and refitted; and scaffolding has been erected to focus on the exterior, especially the front entrance.
