About Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati's motto was 'to the heights' Pope Francis said, "I am reminded of Bl Pier Giorgio – soon to be saint – who in Turin used to go to the homes of the poor to bring help. Pier Giorgio was from a wealthy, upper-middle-class family, but he did not grow up "wrapped in cotton wool", he did not lose himself in the "good life", because within him there was the lifeblood of the Holy Spirit, there was love for Jesus and for his brothers." Pope John Paul II beatified Frassati in 1990.
