World Mission Sunday this weekend, the 18th / 19th October: Last year's Mission Sunday in Ireland raised €1,423,453.00 to which the Diocese of Clogher's contribution was €56,294. Ireland's contribution was sent to the Pontifical Mission Societies which funded 2,710 projects for the education and protection of children, the formation of 6,310 novices and 74,080 seminarians and the building of

751 new churches on five continents. Last year 13 missionaries were murdered. A portion of this week's envelope will go towards this year's Mission Sunday. Mission Sunday Envelopes are available at the churches' bulletin dispensers. This year's theme is *'We are Missionaries of Hope to All.'*
