Feast of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe (Christ the King) – 100th Anniversary: Today, the last Sunday of the Church's Liturgical Year is marked as the Feast of Christ the King. This year marks the 100th anniversary of this feast which Pope Pius XI first proclaimed towards the end of the Holy or Jubilee Year 1925.
