The Baptism of the Lord:

The Christmas Season ends officially with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord after which Jesus began his public ministry in Galilee. The importance of baptism *as the foundation of the identity and mission of the Church* was reaffirmed at the Pre Synodal meetings that took place during Ireland's Synodal Pathway from 2021. These were a response to the announcement by Pope Francis that the universal Church would undergo such a process of prayer, listening, consultation and discernment. The result of pre-synodal meetings attended

by delegates of the dioceses of Ireland at last October's meeting in Kilkenny resulted in a document entitled *'Baptised and Sent'* in which 17 priorities for the future of the Irish Church were refined to 7. The priorities are 1) Belonging, 2) Co-Responsibility, 3) Family, 4) Formation and Catechesis, 5) Healing, 6) The Role and Inclusion of Women in the Church, and 7) Youth. The planning and the formation of actions for the implementation of those priorities will form the purpose of the Irish National Synod due to take place this October.
